We will be a host school to support Jacob a “super student” at Derrimut Heath and Jacob, his family and friends as well as a host of special visitors will arrive around 10:15 am on March the 3rd and mingle in the Courtyard for an hour.


### Bullying Behaviour

Chat to your child’s teacher or to a member of the College leadership team if you have concerns about bullying at Baden Powell College. A significant issue for us at times is the impact of antisocial behaviour on Social Media after school hours. I would ask that you be very vigilant if your child uses social media, and remind them that if they cannot say something face to face then posting on Instagram, Snap Chat or Facebook is not a good idea either!
