Save Our Sons

We had about fifty people, who are walking around Victoria to raise awareness of and funds for the Duchenne Foundation, visit the Derrimut Heath Campus last Tuesday. Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy is a degenerative disease where the muscles progressively lose strength and bulk. It impacts about 1 in 3500 boys, who will lose their ability to walk by the time that they are 12 years old. Currently there is no cure, and life expectancy is around 25 years. We are pleased to support a student who attends Baden Powell College, and will be accepting donations for the next three weeks. We have a **collection tin** at the office at the Derrimut Heath Campus, and members of the Earlyact Club will be out in the schoolyard each day, if you can please send a small donation for the tin!
