



CAR PARKING

Policy 2026

PURPOSE:

The parking of cars and other vehicles in and around the school grounds is a daily necessity but also raises several safety and traffic issues that are required to be managed.

OBJECTIVE:

To ensure that car and vehicle parking in and around the school grounds is orderly, safe and in accordance with the law.

IMPLEMENTATION:

- The parking of any vehicle inside the school grounds is at the discretion of the principal.
- Principal class and some administration staff will have reserved parking, as they frequently move in and out of school during the day.
- The staff car parks are for use by staff members only and will be clearly signposted to reflect and communicate this.
- Disability parking spaces are reserved for authorised permit holders only.
- Vehicles on school grounds must comply with speed restrictions.
- Parents or visitors who park in the staff car parks will be reminded of the need to park elsewhere. Habitual offenders will be referred to the City of Wyndham for prosecution.
- School Council will seek frequent visitations from local parking officers to ensure compliance with parking regulations in the areas surrounding the school.
- The principal class will approach members of the community who are parking inappropriately outside the school grounds.
- All school gates will be securely locked once the school day commences and during outside of school hours.
- The school will encourage students to be active and walk or ride to school. A secure location will be provided at each campus for students to leave their bike/scooter during the school day.
- Damage to vehicles parked on school grounds is not covered by Baden Powell College or the Department of Education's insurance.
- Staff must park in allocated parking bays within the staff car parks.
- Additional parking and traffic arrangements may be implemented during school events, excursions, sporting activities and community functions.
- Visitors parking on school grounds must report to the Administration Office upon arrival.
- Parking arrangements must operate in conjunction with the College Traffic Management Plan.

EVALUATION:

This policy will be reviewed as part of the school's three-year review cycle.
