



STUDENT DRESS CODE Year 7-9

EVERY DAY UNIFORM: Year 7-9

Long grey pant
Grey school shorts
Green check dress (knee length)
Winter check skirt (knee length)
Long / short sleeve white school shirt
Official School tie
Woollen Vest: maroon
Woollen jumper / cardigan: maroon
Official black jacket with logo
Green wide brim hat / slouch hat
Black leather lace-up school shoes
Long dark grey/white socks
Dark grey tights
Hijab: green, white, maroon, black
Hair accessories: bottle green, maroon or white

SPORTS UNIFORM: Year 7-9

Baden Powell College track suit: zip jacket and tracksuit pants – green / maroon
Baden Powell College maroon/green polo shirt
Sports shorts: micromesh, maroon
Plain white runners and white sock

OPTIONAL ITEMS

Bottle green windbreaker/spray jacket
Thin plain black leather belt
Bottle green scarf, beanie and gloves
Official maroon school bag with logo
Approved white tailored girls shirt (may be worn out) only if worn with the skirt
A 'celebratory' item, to be designed and worn by year 9 students, during their final year

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IN RELATION TO SCHOOL UNIFORM: YEAR 7 –9

- Jewellery:** Stud earrings and sleepers worn in the ears, and watches are the only acceptable jewellery.
- Cosmetics:** Other than clear nail polish, cosmetics are not to be worn at school.
- Hair Styles/Colours:** Extreme hair colours (eg: green, pink or purple rinses or dyes) and/or extreme hairstyles (eg: spikes or mohawks) are not permitted.

It is expected that shoulder length or longer (worn by males or females), for safety and health reasons, is tied back using school colours.

UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS:

- The white school shirt must be worn tucked in
- The approved white **tailored girls shirt** can be worn out only with the skirt
- The tie must be worn with all white shirts
- All white shirts must be straight bottomed
- The official dress and skirt must be worn at knee length
- During wet weather it is expected that the school bottle green windbreaker / spray jacket is worn to and from and around the school
- Sports uniform is expected to be worn during all sports lessons and sporting competitions
- Sports uniforms are permitted to be worn to and from school on the students designated sports days and sporting competitions

Wearing of the School Jumper and Vest:

- When wearing either the jumper or the vest the white school shirt **must not be visible** below the jumper / vest bottom.

Black leather lace-up school shoes:

- Black leather lace-up school shoes are the only footwear acceptable as part of the formal uniform.

T-Shirts etc:

- Any garments worn under the school uniform must not be visible.
- Coloured or monogrammed T-Shirts, singlets or skivvies are not permitted to be worn under shirts at any time.

Exception to this policy:

- The Principal may approve out-of-uniform days for fundraising purposes
- Casual Dress Day: The Principal shall allow at their discretion one casual dress day per term
